## Artist makes unique table top

It was a big order, but Shelly LaTreill, owner of SER Art, was up to the task.

LaTreill is a Bedford artist who specializes in stained glass. This summer, she got an order for a custom designed table top for a receptionist's desk at a dentist's office.

She designed it herself and the finished product consists of three parts. The center piece is nearly 5-feet long and its two wings are a little over 4-feet long. Each section weighs 30 pounds and consists of stained glass on a copper background. The center section features a section of mouth-blown glass.

Once she designed the table, it took her two weeks to get all the supplies she needed, including the glass. It then took her three weeks to build it.

It's a one of a kind piece.

"You couldn't do it the same if you tried," LaTreill said.

When the interior designer, who is overseeing the office work, is ready for it, she and her husband, Eric, will deliver it. The black granite desk will then be built around it.
